Product Information

Soil: Clay and limestone. South-East exposure with ample sunshine.

Age of vines: over 60 years old

Vinification: Hand harvest. Filling of the press by gravity. 48 hours settling and long fermentation at low temperature (15/17C). Ageing on the fine lees for about 6 months brings roundness to this wine.

Tasting Note: Light yellow color with golden hues. On the nose pleasant aromas of white fruit and citrus notes. The aging on the lees gives the wine roundness and nobility. A well-balanced wine with beautiful salinity on the finish.

Producer Information

The Tiollier family established the winery in 1840 and now have 50 acres under vine. Located on steep slopes rising out of the southern flank of the Savoie valley and facing the Alps the vineyards are gorged on sunshine. The soil is mainly argilo-calcaire, a gift from the mountains and recognized as one of the best in Savoie. Unique grape varieties like Jacquère, Altesse and Mondeuse thrive in this Alpine climate. Like the meaning of its name, the Domain brings its light-hearted, charming spirit to all the wines they produce
