## DESCRIPTION:

Whitehouse is a bitter wine that accompanies the consumer on a journey through Sicilian history.

It all began in 1773 when Merchand Mr John Whitehouse, finding himself in Marsala, tried to keep some wine he had bought for his trip with alcohol, so, Marsala wine was born from intuition of this man.

Whitehouse takes its name from the "Contrada Casabianca" district where the company is based and proposes the concept of Marsala bitter wine.

It falls into the category of bitter wines due to the predominant presence of gentian and cinchona.

Product is obtained from Marsala wine and some Mediterranean botanicals that link the product to its land of origin

## ORGANOLEPTIC CHARACTERISTICS

Bright amber color. Ethereal perfumes with undergrowth and tobacco nuances. Whitehouse presents notes of flowers and aromatic herbs such as rosemary and laurel.

Complex and enveloping taste that alternates notes of sweetness and bitterness on the palate. Delicately acidic and salty
