*vintage:* 2019

St. Croix, La Crescent, Marquette,  
Frontenac Gris, Blanc and Noir

*vineyard:* Les Bonnes Femmes (home farm  
vineyard). Planted on volcanic soils: clay,  
limestone, schist, gneiss, amphibolites,  
granite, garnet, 1600 feet above sea level.  
Southeast facing slope. Budbreak usually  
the end of May, blossoming around June  
21st, the summer solstice. Full sun. In high  
alpine meadow. Native flora: clovers, native  
grasses, devil's paintbrush, bedstraw, king  
devil, asters. Fog in autumn. Not  
particularly susceptible to frost.

*farming:* Organic and biodynamic.

*vinification:* Overnight whole cluster maceration, destemmed, foot crushed, direct  
press, elevage in glass demijohn.

*tasting note:* A light red with a touch of residual sugar and mild fizz, this is a salubrious  
wine with restrained pomegranate, cranberry fruit and a touch of hibiscus.

*food pairing:* Cured meats, salt pork, meat roasted with fruit, steak tartar, salmon  
tartar, and salmon pot au feu.
