Product Information

Soil: Clay and limestone. South-East exposure with ample sunshine.

Age of vines: over 60 years old

Vinification: Hand harvest. Partial destemming followed by maceration for 10 to 12 days at controlled

temperature. Aged for 6 months in vats.

Tasting Note: Beautiful purple-red color with violet reflections. Bouquet of red berries and spring flowers (violet), peppery notes present. The wine is supple on the palate and has a nice freshness, the finish is enhanced by the tannins which give this wine a nice length in the mouth.

Producer Information

The Tiollier family established the winery in 1840 and now have 50 acres under vine. Located on steep slopes rising out of the southern flank of the Savoie valley and facing the Alps the vineyards are gorged on sunshine. The soil is mainly argilo-calcaire, a gift from the mountains and recognized as one of the best in Savoie. Unique grape varieties like Jacquère, Altesse and Mondeuse thrive in this Alpine climate. Like the meaning of its name, the Domain brings its light-hearted, charming spirit to all the wines they produce
